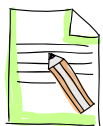
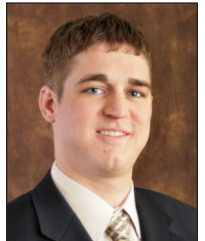

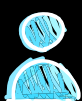
ABOUT THE INSTRUCTOR
